We will have poker hands for \$5.00

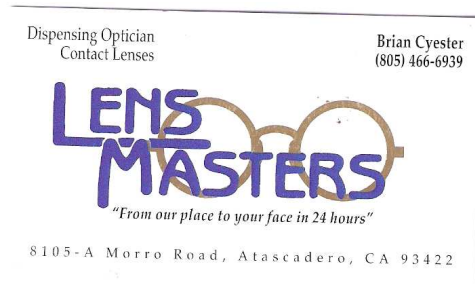
