

February TOUR to Camp Roberts Museum

The Camp Roberts Historical Museum is the largest Army Museum in California, and is located on Camp Roberts, California. (12 miles north of Paso Robles).

The Museum is the repository for the entire history of one of America's largest and most historic Army installations.

The Museum has a great many interesting exhibits in both of its exhibit buildings--the Main Museum and the Museum Annex and has many historic vehicles, both tracked and wheeled, on display.

The topics of its exhibits range from the early ranches and the Salinas Indians through World War II, the Korean War, and Vietnam, to present-day mobilizations to the Middle East.

The Museum has a large gift shop, a video viewing room, a conference room, library and archives, a picnic area, and other facilities. Handicapped ramp and parking are provided at the facility.

Many celebrities have trained at Camp Roberts, including Caspar Weinberger, Red Skelton, Robert Mitchum, and Bob Newhart (see our Wall of Fame).

Admission is FREE to all and Masks are required!

Meeting Place: We will meet at the Paradise Grill parking lot at 9:45 for a 10 AM departure. (From South County take exit 231 off the 101 and turn left onto 24th St. – Turn right on Spring Street and the Grill is two blocks north on your left at 28th St.) Parking is behind the restaurant and bring your Family Radio to keep in touch on the drive. Departure may seem early but we will need to be processed by the Army as we enter the Camp and it could take some time.



Lunch: We plan to depart from Camp Roberts at 12:30 for a scenic off-freeway drive down Estrella Road to Rt 46, under 101 which will take us to 24th St. and then right on Spring St. to our lunch destination at the Paradise Restaurant Bar and Grill at 635 28th St in Paso Robles (our departure point). The restaurant is located at the corner of Spring and 28th St. We have attached the menu as a PDF for your browsing pleasure.
