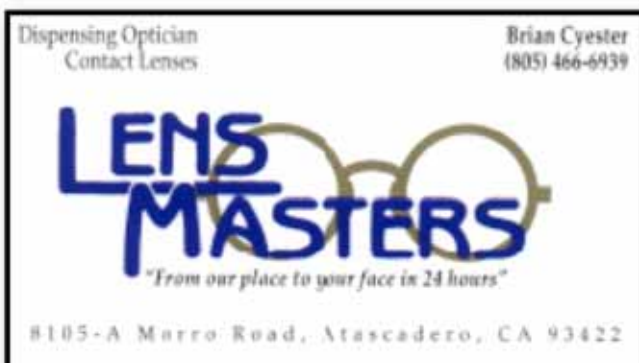

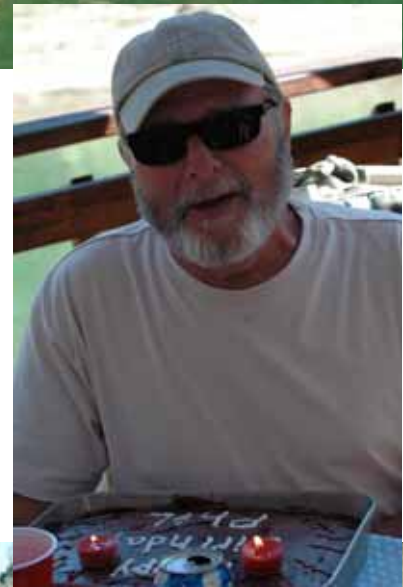
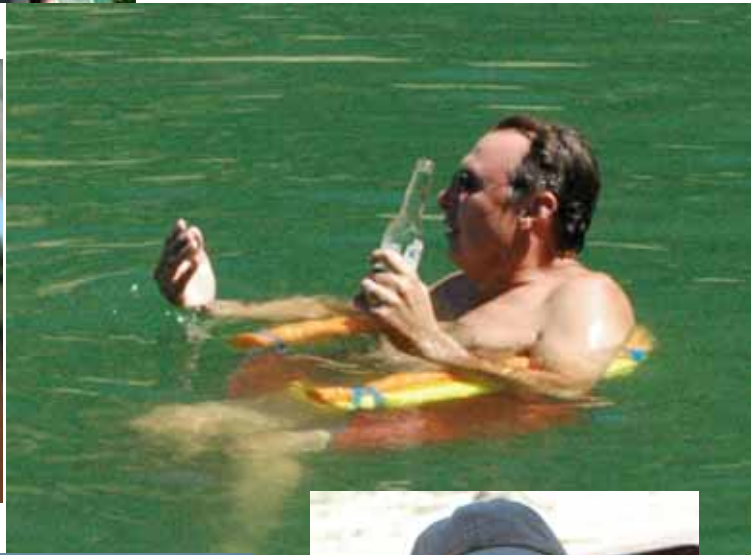

Corvette Named in Vincentric's "2007 Best Value in America" Awards
