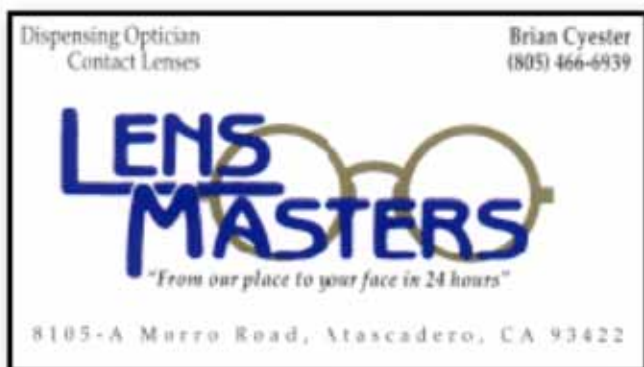
The Ramo's and the Reif's will be cooking.
