SLO VETTES bring home the gold

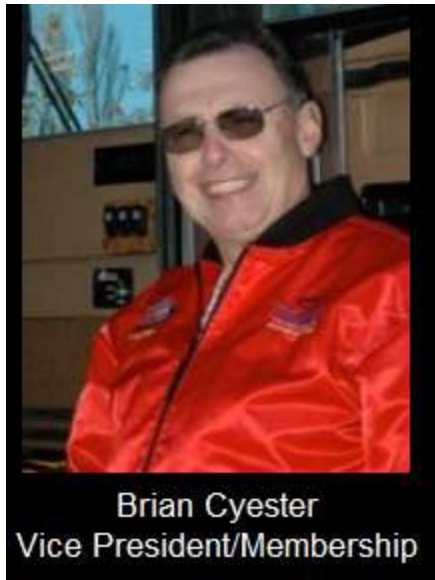
